Anthony's Story

Anthony James McGaw, aged 20 was electrocuted and severely burnt while on a job in Spotswood, working as an apprentice plumber on Thursday 14th of July 2011. On that day, Anthony was lucky to survive, however his horrific and life threatening injuries would change his life and the life of his family forever

Anthony has remained in hospital and now in rehabilitation without movement in his legs but with hope and hard work anything is possible. Anthony will need months, if not years, of rehabilitation to assist him in his recovery. His best chance is through a rehabilitation program in America called, 'Project Walk'.
